### **Ground Rules**

#### **PCSC Inc. FOLLOWS EQUINE CANADA RULES (EC)**

1. Riders must show in at least 3 of our 5 shows (in an individual class) for points.  
(Note: if only 4 shows, riders must show at least 2 to count towards trophies.)
2. Points will commence to count from the time your membership is purchased.
3. Horse MAY NOT be substituted for any reason through the season except in Lead Line.
4. All Riders must be properly attired according to EC and PCSC rules.
5. Exception for Lead Line class, rider must wear proper hard hat with harness and proper foot wear.
6. Hard hat with harness and proper footwear mandatory for children and adults. Harness must be fastened. EC Rules apply for attire. Paddock boots with half chaps are permitted.
7. Horse must be shown in suitable English Tack. EC rules apply for tack.
8. Sportsmanship conduct is expected at all times. NO ALCOHOL, NO FOUL LANGUAGE, NO EXCESSIVE ABUSE on Horse/Pony. Improper conduct will result in forfeiting of membership privileges and/or points. Offending individual may be asked to leave.
9. DRUG USE ON HORSE/PONY STRICKLY PROHIBITED ON SHOW GROUNDS. Horses/Ponies on grounds maybe tested at show mgr. discretion. ZERO TOLERANCE a positive test will result in being banned from future shows and forfeiture of points.
10. Judge's decisions are FINAL. Judge has the authority to request the removal or alteration of any piece of equipment.
11. Disputes should be accompanied with \$25.00 cash deposit to SHOW MGR. The Show Manager is the only individual that is allowed to approach the Judge with a dispute. Anyone approaching the Judge regarding disputes will loose their points for that show.
12. Entries will ONLY be refunded if class is cancelled or the horse/rider becomes physically unable to perform.
13. YOUTH are NOT allowed to handle, show or ride stallions in any class or on park grounds
14. No pets allowed unless on LEASH and under Owner's control.
15. All exhibitors are to ride and use the premises and equipment at OWN RISK and must sign a liability release form at every show. The Club executive and directors are not responsible or liable for any damage, loss or injury to persons or property. Minors must have a waiver signed by parent(s)/guardian(s).
16. OEF insurance membership strongly encouraged. Website for more information: [www.horse.on.ca](http://www.horse.on.ca)
17. Classes will be cancelled if not a least two (2) entries, EXCEPT FOR: Lead Line and Short Stirrup Divisions
18. NSF CHEQUES - \$25.00 LEVY will apply.
19. Any outstanding monies due to PCSC must be paid in full by next show or rider & horse will not be allowed to show until paid. Points will be forfeited.
20. All riders must wear approved ASTM/BSI riding helmets with attached harness in all events run under PCSC sanction and anywhere on the show grounds.
21. Ponies to be ridden according to EC rules.
22. Showing requirements for Short Stirrup and Novice Divisions are as stands with the exception of Lead Line.
23. Competitors not at gate when called into ring will be disqualified with no money refund. The SHOW Mgr. will enforce this.
24. Officials must be notified prior to class if a tack change is required.
25. Warm up ticket will be required to warm up for jumping course. Only 3 riders allowed in the ring at one time, and are allowed to jump the course 2 times each. Warm up will be from 9:00 am to 9:45 am. Any flat work will be done in the sand ring. There will be 2 jumps that will be accessible to warm up in the sand ring.
26. In order to be eligible for a DIVISION'S YEAR END award rider must enter WHOLE division. If rider enters by class they will NOT BE eligible.
27. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR HORSE/HORSES AS WE ARE LOCATED IN A PUBLIC PARK
